**DSA Chair Report 2017**

- DSAuk continues to develop and grow, both in terms of membership numbers and the offer to our members, families and groups we support.

**Membership**

- Membership increased by over 110 during 2017, taking the association to 2,350 members, who we support by providing regular sporting and recreational activities helping to improve self-esteem, physical fitness health and wellbeing.

**DSAuk Regions**

- **DSAuk** does this by providing regular sporting and recreational activities through our regional structure. DSAuk delivers a broad range of sporting events and social activities as well as engaging the local communities through our schools and community group programme.
- During 2017 DSAuk regions organised over 200 events, including
  - ✓ 180 Sporting events
  - ✓ Reaching over 3,500 pupils and teachers through our schools' programme
  - ✓ Designing and delivering a Teacher training workshop in partnership with Worcester University

- **DSAuk Regions (continued)**
- DSAuk played an active role in national campaigns to increase access to sport and recreational activities for disabled people
- Partnering with the English Federation of Disability Sport (EFDS) we commissioned a research piece on the benefits of recreational activity and independent living. The findings will be published in 2018
- DSAuk works in partnership with both 'Little People UK' and 'Restricted Growth Association' attending conferences, running sporting events for their members and engaging in joint projects to raise awareness of the barriers and issues faced by dwarfs and people with restricted growth conditions.

**Creating New Opportunities**

- DSAuk works at creating different opportunities for its members and associates to engage in sport, recreation and personal development.
- DSAuk sent a GB team of 80 athletes and over 150 supporters to the World Dwarf Games in Canada
- Badminton was finally recognised as an official Paralympic sport. The DSAuk team will be attending Tokyo Olympics in 2020.

**Plans for 2018**

- DSAuk will be increasing its focus on supporting new and existing members to move from inactive to active DSAuk citizens by offering a mixed programme of sporting and recreational events, including
  - Cage cricket: A dynamic, visually exciting sport aimed at engaging and embracing members into the DSA family
  - Recreational Activity Weekend, aimed at building individual self-esteem and sense of independence for members across the age group
- Our regions continue to expand, offering regular activity within an hour's travel to members.

**Grant Funding**

- DSAuk relies on grant funding to support and fund our staff positions and are grateful for the continued support from Children In Need, Sport England and Gentleman's Night Out.
- Our renewed partnership with Sport England enables us to deliver a comprehensive programme of sporting and recreational events.

**Reserve Funds**

- DSAuk has several reserve funds. A £20,000 reserve to secure the associations event programme if funding is not found.
- A DSAuk core cost reserve, representing one year's overhead cover of £19,000.
- A reserve fund of £8,551 as a contingency fund if the charity has a period of time when staff funding is not available.

NOTES TO STATEMENTS OF FINANCIAL ACTIVITIES (SOFA)  
YEAR ENDED 31ST DECEMBER 2017**

**1. THE BASIS OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES AND DEFINITIONS**

- 1.1 THE ACCOUNTS** have been prepared under the historical cost convention in accordance with applicable accounting standards and the Charities Act 2006 and Statement of Recommended Practice (SORP) 2005.
- 1.2 GENERAL FUNDS** represent unrestricted funds that are not subject to any restriction regarding their use and are available for application towards their use purposes of a general nature.
- 1.3 RESTRICTED FUNDS** represent funds restricted by the donor for a particular purpose.
- 1.3(a) DESIGNATED FUNDS** represent funds that have been allocated out of Unrestricted funds by the Trustees of DSAUK, for specific events or liabilities DSAuk is committed to. Any remaining balance is returned to unrestricted funds when events have been held.
- 1.4 INCOMING RESOURCES** are included in the SOFA when:-
- DSAuk becomes entitled to the resources
  - The trustees are virtually certain they will receive the resources; and
  - The monetary value can be measured with sufficient reliability.
- 1.5 GRANTS & DONATIONS** are included in the SOFA when DSAuk has unconditional entitlement to the resources.
- 1.6 INVESTMENT INCOME** is included in the SOFA when receivable.
- 1.7 RESOURCES EXPENDED** are recognised when costs have been incurred, or for designated or special gifts, in the same accounting period as the related gift is received.
- 1.8 TANGIBLE FIXED ASSETS** are capitalised at cost when incurred, or for assets bought in previous years, at valuation in 2017. The valuation of assets from previous years was identified as income, in Voluntary Incoming Resources.
- 1.9 DEPRECIATION OF FIXED ASSETS** is included in resources expended, to write off the assets of over their useful life, - 3 years for Bikes & 4 years for other equipment.
- 1.10 LIABILITY RECOGNITION** – Liabilities are recognised as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to pay out resources.
- 1.11 GOVERNANCE COSTS** – The preparation & examination of DSAuk’s annual statutory accounts, AGM & trustee meeting expenses; also legal advice given to trustees.
